- Research and review the life and legacy of the general Supervisor whose scholarship you are applying for. Using the references and links provided, decide how your life parallels the life of this honorable woman of God.

Continued:

- Complete a video essay describing what makes this general Supervisor's work and service most connected with your life experiences. Explain makes you the most eligible candidate for this scholarship that honors her service.
