Mason Homes on 4<sup>th</sup> is a 77-unit affordable rental townhome project located on 6.34 acres. The project is a public-private partnership with the City of Memphis Division Housing Community Development and the Memphis Housing Authority.

### PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP

The **City of Memphis Division of Housing Community Development** provided a **\$4 Million Ioan** for the construction of the project and The **Memphis Housing Authority** is providing **38 Project Based Vouchers**. The **Health, Educational and Housing Facility Board of the City of Memphis** was the issuer **Tax-Exempt Revenue Bonds** and provided a **20-year PILOT** (Payment In Lieu of Property Taxes).

"This is a classic public-private partnership", said Saki Middleton, President of John Stanley, Inc." The \$4 Million loan from the City of Memphis Housing and Community Development and the 19 Project Based Vouchers from the Memphis Housing Authority is the key to this project becoming a reality"." It will improve the quality and stability of the neighborhood."

Presiding Bishop Charles E. Blake, Sr. says "the Church of God in Christ is excited and honored to provide new housing for the residents of Memphis. This joint project with the city of Memphis and others, adjacent to the COGIC World Headquarters the historic Mason Temple, will allow families the opportunity to live in a beautiful, affordable, safe, gated community."

#### ABOUT THE PROJECT

Designed by **Self Tucker Architects**, the **77-unit affordable townhome housing project** will consist of 30 buildings located on approximately 6.34 acres. The project will have approximately 29, 2-story townhome designed buildings with one separate community building for residents. The project will have **59 two bedrooms/1.5 bath and 18 three bedroom/two bath homes**. Amenities will include a playground, bbq area, sitting areas and a 2,500 square foot community building with a lounge, kitchen, flex room, gym and a computer/classroom. The units will serve family households whose annual household incomes are at or below 60% of the Shelby County area median

income.
