Friday, July 19, 2019 - The Journey Begins

Depart the US for Israel LX 017, 19JUL, JFK/ZRH, 6:10P – 8:00A (20JUL)

Saturday, July 20, 2019 – Welcome Home (D)

LX 252, 20JUL, ZRH/TLV, 9:45A - 2:35P

Shalom and welcome to Israel. Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport (2:35pm), meet your driver and your Tour Educator. Drive to Tel Aviv and start with a visit to Old Jaffa and hear about those who have left their mark on the city, like Jonah and his Whale, Andromeda, Simon the Tanner, Napoleon and more. Time permitting travel north along the Mediterranean to Caesarea and explore the Roman Theatre, check out the great acoustics by singing your favorite songs and hymns, and the Crusader Fortress with its mysterious dry moat.

Overnight: Kibbutz Lavi, Hod/Hadar Wing

Sunday, July 21, 2019 – Land of Miracles (B, D)

In the morning travel to Nazareth, to visit the Church of the Annunciation and the ancient synagogue where Jesus preached. On your way view the Wedding Church at Kana of Galilee.

Return to the Sea of Galilee area to the village of Magdala, which was the home of Mary Magdalene. A very important archeological find has recently been discovered at this fishing village. Continue to the seaside fishermen town of Capernaum where Jesus made his ministry headquarters. See how new emerging Christian Community lives side by side with existing Jewish Community.

In the afternoon drive north to visit the Bannias Springs, site of Caesari of Philippi

Late afternoon ascend the Golan Heights and peer deep into Syria from atop Mt. Bental. View the Upper Galilee and understand the importance of the Golan Heights.

Dinner at the Decks Restaurant

Overnight: Kibbutz Lavi, Hod/Hadar Wing

Monday, July 22, 2019 – Sea of Galilee Cruise, Baptism, Pilgrimage Route (B, D)

Start the day with a cruise on the Sea of Galilee from Tiberias to Kibbutz Ginosar. After landing see the "Jesus Boat". This particular archaeological find is believed to be from the first century and was discovered during a drought and had been buried for 2000 years on the shore of the Sea of Galilee. This fishing boat is similar to the vessel described in the Gospels, which carried Jesus and his apostles.

Drive to Yardenit, Baptismal site in the Jordan River. Continue south along the Jordan Valley, past Jericho to Jerusalem. On your way south view the Gilboa Mountain and see the story of David and Saul unfold before you along with other events from the Bible.

Ascend to Jerusalem and pause at a vantage point for a spectacular view and to say a prayer of thanks, as said by pilgrims for thousands of years when arriving in Jerusalem Overnight: Grand Court Hotel, Jerusalem

Tuesday, July 23, 2019 – Community Learning Activity (B, D)

In the morning meet the Youth On A Mission (YOAM) for mutual activity in Bethlehem and at an Absorption Center In the afternoon meeting with David Nekrutman of CJCUC Overnight: Grand Court Hotel, Jerusalem

Wednesday, July 24, 2019 – Jerusalem, the City of Peace (B, D)

Start the day with a visit to the City of David to discover the "original" Jerusalem. Walk through the Hezekiah Tunnel, dug in biblical times to bring water to Jerusalem. View the Southern Wall Excavations and see the Temple Steps and the site of the Moneychangers' stalls

Enjoy a spiritual visit to the Western Wall, the holiest place of the Jewish People.

Explore the Western Wall Tunnels stretching under the Old City (pending confirmation)

Ascend to the Jewish Quarter to see the Cardo, a 1,800 year old shopping mall still in use today and the Broad Wall. Continue to Shorashim at the heart of the Jewish Quarter. Exit the Old City via Zion Gate to visit Mt Zion, the site of King David's Tomb, founder of Jerusalem 3,000 years ago and the Upper Room, generally accepted as the Last Supper Hall. Overnight: Grand Court Hotel, Jerusalem

Thursday, July 25, 2019 – Jerusalem of Gold (B, D)

Start the day with the most spectacular view over the city of Jerusalem from atop the Mount of Olives. Descend to The Garden of Gethsemane via the Chapel of Dominus Flevit and visit the Church of All Nations (Gethsemane). Ascend from the Kidron Valley, past Absalom's Tomb to Caiaphas's House and view the Dungeon. Enter the Old City via Zion Gate, stroll the Old City alleys and explore the Oriental Bazaar (Suk), where haggling has been raised to an art, and walk along the Via Dolorosa.

Exit the city via Nablus Gate to enjoy a communion at the Garden Tomb
