- _____ 1. Only high school seniors currently in the 12th grade or current college students may apply.
- _____ 2. Complete the scholarship application and acknowledgement that you have read the 2026-2027 Application Checklist and the 2026-2027 Application Instructions. All responses are documented and saved on the application.
- _____ 3. Access the link to the recommendation form. You will need two professional recommendations. One must be from your Pastor.
- _____ 4. Review the essay questions and type your responses. Each essay should be 500 words or less and is worth 25 points. Essays submitted as emails, attachments or links will not be accepted.
- _____ 5. High school seniors currently in the 12th grade must upload an unofficial high school transcript. Make a copy in .PDF format to be uploaded/attached at the bottom of the application. (If you are selected, official transcripts will be required to receive the award.)
- _____ 6. College students must upload an unofficial college transcript. Make a copy in .PDF format to be uploaded/attached at the bottom of the application. (If you are selected, official transcripts will be required to receive the award.)
