10 Necessary Strengths

- **Character** – Leaders cannot rise above the limitation of their character. Someone once said, “*Don’t let your gift take you where it can’t keep you.*”
- **Competence** – Quality is the request of study, and excellence is the choice of performance.
- **Commitment** – The real measure of commitment is seen in the effort one puts into an endeavor.
- **Charisma** – A leader who is charismatic not only likes the job of leading but also likes people, and has the ability to draw people to him.
- **Communicators** – A successful leader must be able to share information and transmit a sense of emergency and enthusiasm to others.

10 Necessary Strengths (cont'd)

- **Creative** – Effective leaders do not get stuck with, “***This is the way it’s always been done.***” They create and initiate new ideas constantly.
- **Contributing** – Great leaders are generous. It comes from the heart and permeates every aspect of a leader’s life, touching his time, money, talents, and possessions.
- **Connected** – Staying connected means having a loyalty and faithfulness that goes beyond all personal feelings. In order to stay connected, we must *submit*.
- **Consistent** – Consistency is a virtue which implies one who is willing to exercise patience, perseverance, passion, and persistence in the pursuit of worthy goals.
- **Controlling** – Success on any major scale requires you to accept responsibility, which means to maintain control of your organization.

Church Growth



- A church will never grow beyond its capacity to meet needs.

- People need fewer **“ought to”** sermons and more **“how to”** sermons.
- When God's Word is taught in an uninteresting way, people don't just think the pastor is boring; they think God is boring.

- In genuine worship, God’s presence is felt, God’s pardon is offered, God’s proposes are revealed, and God’s power is displayed.
- Making a service comfortable for the unchurched doesn’t mean changing your theology. It means changing the environment.
- Being seeker sensitive doesn’t limit what you say, but it does affect how you say it!
- Increasing the size of your church is simple: You must get more people to visit! A crowd is not a church; but to grow a larger church, you must first attract a crowd!
