7 Steps to the Kingdom

1. Greeting: (Smile. Get a verbal contract.)
“Hello, May I have one minute of your time? “
2. State:
“Did you know that Jesus Christ is Lord? Well, he is, and he loves you and wants to be your Lord and Savior. A lot of people want to be saved but just don’t know how.” This brings this step brings in the presence of the Holy Spirit.
3. Say:
Romans 10:9 says: “if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God raised Jesus from the dead, you shall be saved. “Do you believe that?”
4. Ask the question:
“Can you say Lord Jesus?” (Wait for them to say it. This step brings in the presence of the Holy Spirit.)
5. Pray:
“Let’s pray, repeat after me: Lord Jesus, forgive me for all my sins. I believe that you died on the cross, were buried, and on the third day God the Father raised you from the dead. Right now, Lord Jesus, I open the door to my HEART and I receive you, into my HEART, as my Lord and Savior.”
6. Question:
“According to the prayer that you just prayed, where is the Lord Jesus?”
The response should be “he’s in my heart.” If some other statement is given, pray again.
7. Confirmation: When the correct answer is given, share:
I John 4:4 says, “Greater is He that is in you than he that is in the world.”
