This 8-hour course is conducted with interactive learning to hundreds of perspective homebuyers that are taught the language of real estate, money management, financing opportunities and how to create, secure and transfer generational wealth.

The Homebuyer Education Course is an eight hour class in which perspective homebuyers receive valuable tools that will help them successfully navigate through the homebuying process. This includes financial and credit management, shopping for a home, purchase procedures and maintaining the home.
