Description of program

Implementation Steps:

- 1. Establish a scholarship committee
- 2. Create an action plan to include categories and criteria for awards. Include all grade level or grade span in the event. For example: Excellent attendance, Citizenship, Academics, Fine Arts and Sports. Remember to recognize high grade point averages (valedictorian and salutatorian)
- 3. Create action steps:
 - a. Date, Time, and Location
 - b. Cost for tickets
 - c. Decoration
 - d. Book Youth inspiration speaker
 - e. Work on advertising and marketing the event
 - f. Menu
 - g. Recruit student performs
- 4. Ask schools and business to help with donated items to auction during the event to gain additional revenue.
