- 1. A completed application form.
- 2. A **one page letter** describing how the scholarship will benefit you in the pursuit of your degree.
- 3. A letter of recommendation from your pastor, **on church letterhead,** that describes your active involvement in your local church.
- 4. A copy of the letter of acceptance from the college, university or vocational school you will be attending OR A transcript showing the college program that you are currently enrolled in.
- 5. After researching the lives of the past and present General Supervisors of the Church of God in Christ, write a one-page Essay describing the qualities and characteristics that you most admire in only one of these honorable women of God.
