4 FINANCES

For the year 2016, the Department has received a total of \$145,744 in deposits. This is a total deposit that is \$6,985 higher than the previous year. This has been acquired through donations, reports, seed offerings and special fundraising efforts.

In regard to the last four years (2013-2016) there has been a grand total of \$540,252 in deposits. The increments have been as follows:

2013:	\$129,267
2014:	\$126,482
2015:	\$138,759
2016:	\$145,744

Where has all of this money gone? Around \$68,000 per year covers all of our AIM Convention and administrative costs (honorariums, official offerings, souvenir journal pages, etc.). The majority of our funds are used to undergird the vision of our Presiding Bishop to reach the world. This is done through the many vehicles of ministry that the Church Of God In Christ affords. Much of the funds are turned in during the International Holy Convocation. We are excited that the International Department of Evangelism has:

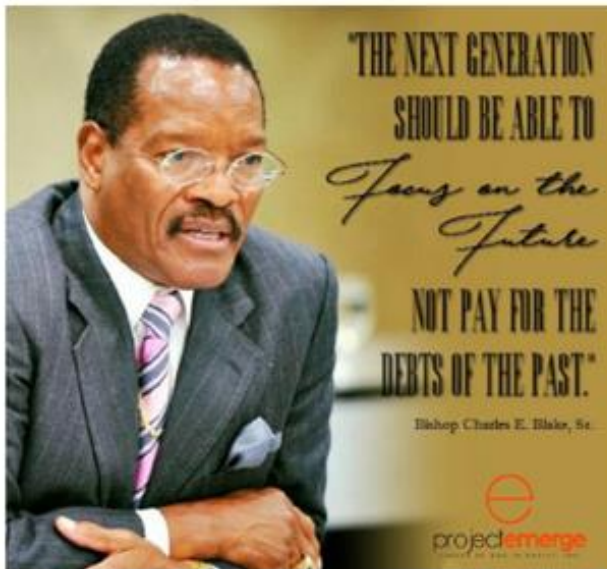
1. Supporting the work of COGIC Charities; which ministers to the down trodden, especially in times of disaster.
2. Supporting COGIC World Missions; which is expanding the work of the Church Of God In Christ around the world.
3. Partnering with God's Outreach Ministry to provide Christmas toys to the needy in Charlotte, North Carolina; where 1,000 people were in attendance and 450 SOULS WERE SAVED!
4. Providing our share of proceeds towards the efforts of the national church. Revival Fire alone (which has been led by Dr. Dorinda Clark-Cole and Supt. Wayne Aaron Robbins) has contributed approximately \$60,000 to the national church.
5. Returning funds of \$9,750 to the national church. These funds were shared with us at the beginning of this administration, in 2013.

The department maintains a healthy balance in the operating account at all times. Our goal is to keep no less than \$100,000 in the treasury. Every month our books are reconciled with Bank of American and also with Chief Financial Officer, Elder Tyrone Potts; to ensure that we are compliant with national procedures!

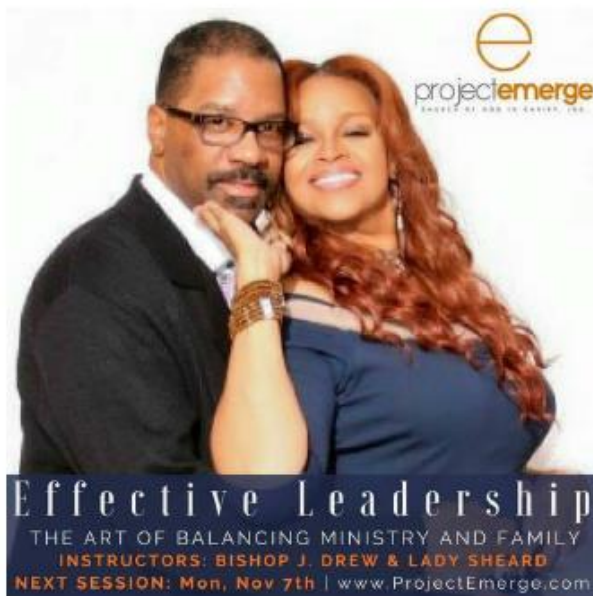
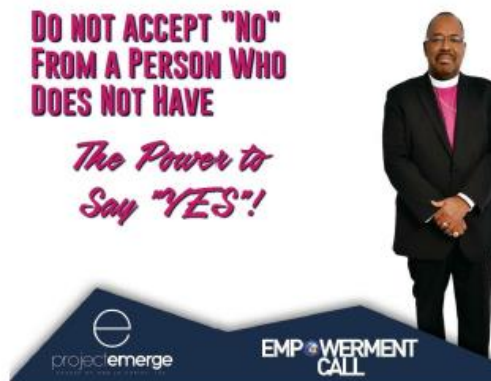

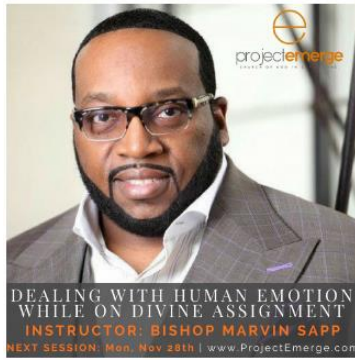
Project Emerge

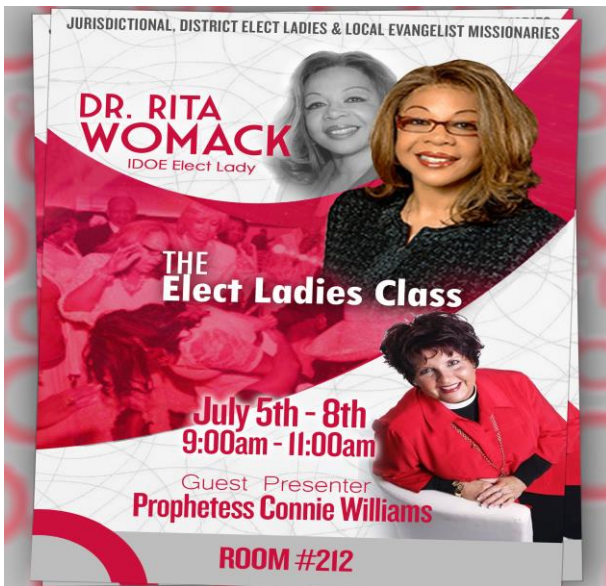
WOMEN'S MINISTRY

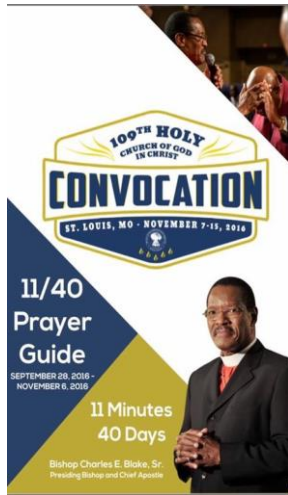

Attorney White paid the entire bill of \$60,000.00 to fund the event! Thank you Jesus! Missouri Midwest had the blessing of being free, to be able to focus totally on soul winning and showing the love of Christ.

Our Presiding Bishop, this year, encouraged us to envision seeing people lined up to get into our churches. Over 5,000 people showed up and lined up for this event! The line was blocks long, traffic was backed up for blocks and every time the volunteers would empty out the church (to give the turkeys) it would fill right back up again.

There was no paid advertisement for this event; just word of mouth. The Saint Louis community saw (once again) that the local Church Of God In Christ cares for the total man. God did it!


More importantly, the Jurisdictional Departments of both Missions and Evangelism (and many other departments) worked together to see souls brought into the Kingdom! While

large groups of people waited in the church to get their turkeys; the pastors of Missouri Midwest preached, sang and prayed with the people! God gets all the glory!

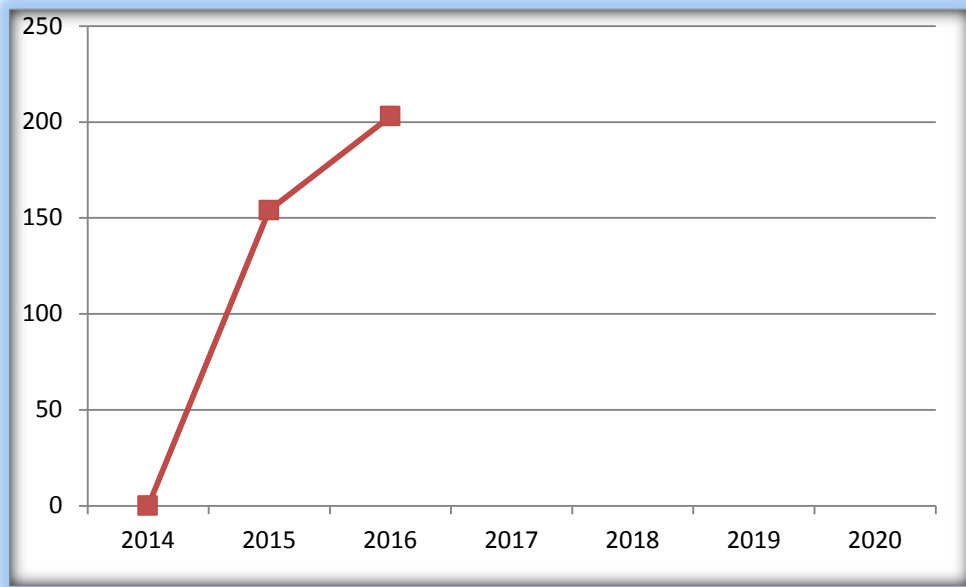

6. **Celebrate the 90th Year of the International Department of Evangelism.**

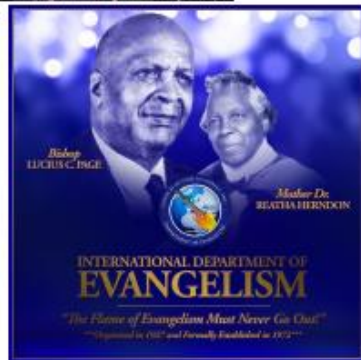
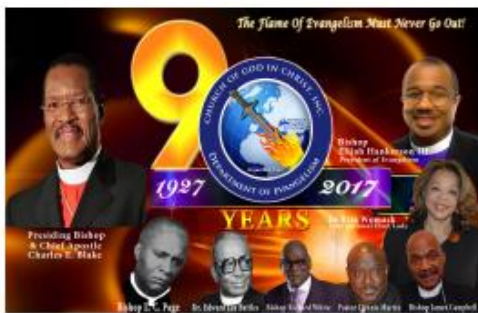

CHALLENGES AND SOLUTIONS

Our challenges remain the same...

1. Having our jurisdictions to appoint individuals that can manage their respective departments. Often individuals are tremendous preachers and/or soul winners but lack the skill to administrate or develop and manage a team. Our task is to continue to train our presidents in the area of administration.

Update: Many of the bishops of the Church Of God In Christ are now appointing presidents that have a heart for evangelism and also administrative skills to lead a department!

3. Follow up. This continues to be a major challenge. While it is exhilarating to see large numbers of souls come to Christ, it also can be frustrating to figure out how to “close the back door” and lead those souls into discipleship and stable church membership. Our strategy is to implement a “follow up ministry” which will teach evangelism workers how to lead new converts in the next step of discipleship.
