## CELEBRATION OF LIFE THE RIGHT REVEREND JAMES LEE WHITEHEAD, JR.

Bishop James L. Whitehead Jr., the only son born to Administrative Assistant James L. Whitehead Sr., and National Evangelist & Purity Lady Ella Barbara Gillespie Whitehead on June 6, 1942, in the city of Detroit, MI. Reared in a strict Christian home, he matriculated through the Detroit and Highland Park Public School Systems, where he also studied music at the Detroit Conservatory of Music. Graduating from High School in 1959, he went on to pursue higher education and music at Saints Junior College in Lexington, MS.

It was at Saints Junior College where he acknowledged his calling to the ministry. Upon graduation he continued his education at Morehouse College in Atlanta, Georgia; Wayne State University in Detroit, Michigan; and Western Theological Seminary in Holland, MI, earning the following degrees: an Associate of Arts, Bachelor's degree, Master of Social Work and a Master of Divinity.

On August 3, 1974, Bishop James Whitehead and Evangelist Mollie Ann Cannon were joined in holy matrimony, producing three saved, talented and college trained children; Gwen Lu'el, James Lee the III, and Shekina Mary.

After many years of study and exposure to great men, Bishop Whitehead became a well-respected preacher of the gospel within the Church Of God In Christ. Bishop Whitehead was the spiritual father to the members of Saints City & Whitehead Memorial, "One church in two locations". He began his first pastorate at the Saints City church in Romulus, MI in 1972. Then following the demise of his father in 1986, he was assigned as pastor to continue the work at the church he grew up in, which at the time was called Mt. Zion, and then renamed Whitehead Memorial in honor of his father. He had a passion for Youth ministry as well as teaching, preaching, singing, and counseling.

One of his greatest honors of his ministry was to bring the Quadrennial Sermon for the Inauguration of Bishop Gilbert E. Patterson, the General Board and the Installation of the National Church Officials in 2005.

Bishop Whitehead had a legacy of faithful service in many areas of the church. During his time at Morehouse, he served as Youth Minister at Hinsley Temple Church Of God In Christ and helped to grow the youth department to the second largest youth ministry in the state. He served Michigan Southwest Jurisdiction as the State Dean of Sunday School from 1960-1984 under the leadership of Bishop John Seth Bailey.

- Community Relations Director of the former International Youth Congress
- Organizer of the Centennial Celebration in Lexington, MS under the leadership of Presiding Bishop Chandler D. Owens
- Editor-in-Chief of the YPWW Literature
- Editor-in- Chief of the Whole Truth Paper
- Chairman/President of the O.T. Jones Memorial Training Institute
- UMI Liaison of International Sunday School Literature

• Chairman of the COGIC Review Commission Team.

Bishop Whitehead was influenced by some of the greatest leaders of our church, which helped to shape his ministry and preaching style, such as: Dr. Arenia Mallory, Bishop O.T. Jones Jr., and Bishop Ithiel Clemons to name a few, whom in his opinion, possessed the spirit and the letter of Biblical preaching. He was also influenced by individuals such as Bishop F. D. Washington, along with other great Ecumenical preachers such as Rev. Caesar Clark, Rev. William Holms Borders, Rev. Gardner Taylor, Mordechai Johnson, Dr. Benjamin Mays, Dr. Martin L. King Jr. and Dr. Sandy Ray, just to name a few. There were other fatherly examples such as: Bishop Levi Willis, Sr., Bishop Roy L. H. Winbush, Sr., Bishop P. A. Brooks, Bishop Earl J. Wright, Sr., Bishop Isaac King, Jr. and Bishop William Rimson, all who left an indelible impact upon his life.

During the Fall General Assembly of 2009 in Memphis, TN, then Administrative Assistant Whitehead was recommended and elevated to the office of Auxiliary Bishop in the Church of God In Christ and was consecrated in November 2010 during the 103rd Holy Convocation. In 2015, after the demise of his mentor and Jurisdictional Prelate, Bishop Earl J. Wright Sr., and serving for over 30 years as First Administrative Assistant, Bishop Whitehead received a unanimous recommendation by the pastors to be the next Jurisdictional Prelate of Michigan Southwest Second Jurisdiction COGIC, confirmed by the Presiding Bishop Charles E. Blake Sr. and the General Board.

Bishop James Whitehead Jr. was a one of the greatest scholars, theologian, and preacher of the gospel of our time, not only within the Church Of God In Christ but throughout the world. His labor and impact will never be forgotten. He was preceded in death by his father James L. Whitehead, Sr., and his mother Ella Barbara Whitehead. He leaves to cherish his memory, his loving wife Mollie Ann Whitehead, his children; Gwen Lu'el (Pastor, Dr. Avery E.) Brown, James (Takia) Whitehead III and Shekina (Caleb) Foster; granddaughter, Alana Brown; three grandsons, Jullian Brown, James Whitehead IV and Jacob Whitehead; his loving sister, LaBarbara Whitehead; a host of cousins, friends and mentors; the members of Saints City and Whitehead Memorial Church, the Michigan Southwest Second Jurisdiction and his beloved grand ole Church of God In Christ.
