Dress Code for The Clergy:

Civic Attire is to be worn by all:

- Elders
- Pastors
- District Superintendents
- Administrative Assistants

Please note Civic Attire is defined as:

- Uninterrupted conservative black suit (one or two button, no stripes, no pic stitching, no pocket squares, no lapel pins)
- Clergy shirt with a solid white band clergy collar (the color clergy shirt worn is based on designated rank)
- Solid black belt, socks, and conservative black shoes (with a black sole and heel) without buckles or decoration
- A watch and wedding ring are items of jewelry which may be worn with Civic Attire

Ceremonial Attire (Vestments) is to be worn by all:

- Members of the College of Bishops
- National Adjutant Brothers (approved and assigned to serve)

Dress Code for the Department of Women:

Ceremonial Attire is to be worn by all:

- Jurisdictional Supervisors
- Credential Holding Women
- National Adjutant Sisters (approved and assigned to serve)

Please note Ceremonial Attire is defined as:

- White Habit (The Saint) with belt and cap (the Habit should not be worn or modified with other items)
- Jurisdictional Supervisors are to wear the Stole and Cord with Cross in the Ceremonial Attire
- Cap should fit properly and neatly. Proper hosiery and shoes should be worn (uninterrupted white)
- A watch and wedding ring are items of jewelry which may be worn with the Habit
- All other ladies are asked to wear white

Finally, please feel free to wear church attire of your choice during other worship services.
