It shall be the responsibility of the President to translate the purpose and policies of the Board into a detailed, concrete program and carry it out in harmony. The president shall submit an annual budget and shall make an annual report on the status and operation of the College to the Board.

Accreditation: All Saints Bible College is authorized for operations as a postsecondary educational institution by the Tennessee Higher Education Commission. All Saints Bible College is accredited by the Association for Biblical Higher Education Commission on Accreditation to grant Certificates and degrees at the Associate and Baccalaureate levels.
